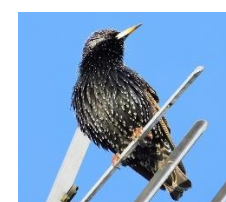

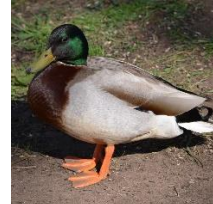

More than 200 species of birds can be seen in Britain. More than half are resident species and live here all year round. The 16 species above are all resident species and can be seen in parks and gardens at any time of year.

There are a lot of birds that only spend the summer here like the Swallow and the Cuckoo, and others like the Pink-footed Goose and the Fieldfare that only visit in the winter.

When you see a bird, do not try to get too close and don't try to look into nests as this can scare the parent birds away. If they have eggs or young in the nest the parents might abandon them. Then the chicks will die and the eggs will not hatch.
