Birds have different coloured and shaped feet



Duck



Crow



Egret



Kestrel



Coot



Pigeon

Ducks have webbed feet, they use them to paddle through the water. They only have 3 toes, each with a small claw.

Crows have 4 toes with large claws. 3 toes point forward and 1 points back.

Egrets have long thin toes which they spread out when they walk on soft ground.

Kestrels have strong feet and sharp talons on their toes to hold on to their prey.

Coots have large feet with wide toes. This helps them to move over swampy ground.

Pigeons have small toes they use to hold on to branches when they rest in trees.
